Restaurants in the hotel are Perkins and Wrigley's Field (a perky little sports bar) and there are plenty of restaurants nearby on Lake Street. You are also right across the street from a large shopping mall with grocery store, pharmacy, coffee, and so forth.

We will be transporting you to and from the campus via passenger van.

Niagara airbus has a flat rate per person; 5-0 and Central charge per trip (approx \$100.00-\$120.00 Canadian for both Toronto and Buffalo airports) , so if you share a ride it is cheaper. If you know when you are arriving and want to coordinate with others, you can give me the details of your flights and arrival times and I can book for you on this side of the border. Please do the coordinating among yourselves and then contact me if you'd like me to contact the taxi. Depending on Traffic, the ride from Toronto can be an easy 70-90 minutes or a nightmare of 2-3 hours (try to arrive so that you can be on the road before 3:00pm or after 7:00pm; between 7-9 am is also really ugly. Buffalo is less onerous, but you will have to contend with the border. BRING YOUR PASSPORT.)
